The b|u|s training program splits into two central training modules, each lasting three days. The second module helps you identify marketing and business opportunities around you and learning how to harness them effectively. For those ready to take the next step, an optional third module guides you in creating a compact business plan for a specific idea.

- > Boost Your Skills: Build practical management abilities for greater success.

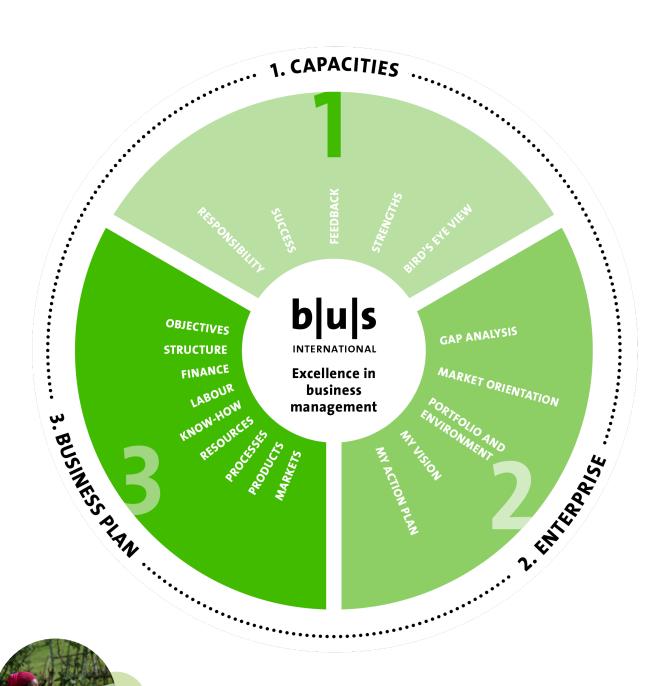

The b|u|s modules: 3×3 days for your success*

*modules 1 and 2 are interconnected and compulsory. Module 3 is optional.



Capacities

In the first module, you analyze your skills, potential and limits. You will work though questions like: Do I take on responsibilities or do I tend to avoid them? What are my personal success factors? Am I able to make decisions, do I have self-confidence, do I stand by my decisions once I have made them? Where are my limits? How do I deal with others, with family members, with business partners?

You are also encouraged to take a closer look at your business and its potential, first from a bird's eye view and then from an economic perspective.



In the second module, you assess your market situation. Could I improve my position in the value-added chain? Which products should I phase out and which are positioned in a growing market segment? How and to whom can I sell my products?

This assessment will help you to define your own entrepreneurial path forwards. What is my vision in 10 years' time? What different paths can my family and I take to achieve this vision? What criteria should I use to find out which is the right path? At the end of this phase, you will have clear ideas and a concrete action plan for the next steps.

Optional: Business Plan Compact

In the third module, you translate the right path into a business plan. Step by step you learn how to work out the content needed to establish or carry on your business. At the end of module b|u|s 3, you will have the competence to write a clear and compact business plan with which you can go to a local bank and ask for a loan to make potential required investments.
